Why Coinbase Closes Accounts

Coinbase may temporarily or permanently close accounts for:

- Suspicious activity
- Failed identity checks
- Chargebacks or disputed payments
- Terms of service violations
- Compliance or regulatory review

If You Can't Log In at All

Try:

- ✔ Password reset
